Fashion designer Joanna Mastroianni presented her Fall 2007 collection at the Salon in the Bryant Park tents on Thursday, February 8, 2007, marking the designer's twentieth year in the fashion industry.

Inspired by the artistry and appearance of a 19th Century Byzantine cross, Joanna Mastroianni sent down the runway limited edition pieces reflecting bold shades of copper, ruby and cognac women's wear and accessories to include eloquent evening gowns, cocktail dresses, and everyday apparel. Mastroianni worked with rich, sophisticated fabrics and textures, intertwined with metallic and hand-embroidered accessories. The collection is versatile, accessible, and exhibits great workmanship, juxtaposed with a sensual modern silhouette.
