

WINTER ANTIQUES SHOW A BENEFIT FOR EAST SIDE HOUSE SETTLEMENT 53RD YEAR

The Winter Antiques Show marked its 53rd year as the most prestigious antiques show in America at the Seventh Regiment Armory on Park Ave at 67th Street in New York City Jan. 19-28th. On loan this year was a sampling from the Museum of Early Decorative Arts. All revenues from the Show's general admissions and the net proceeds from the preview parties go to East Side House and contribute substantially to its private philanthropic budget.

East Side House, founded in 1891, has served New York's Mott Haven section of the Bronx since 1963. A staff of 210, including full and part-time teachers, social workers and other experts serve over 8,000 residents. One of their specific focuses is early childhood and adolescence. The program enriches, supplements, and enhances the public school system and places college within reach of motivated students.
